





Summer Eco Explorers Now Accepting Registrations for FREE Youth Summer Programming at Mass Audubon's Allens Pond Wildlife Sanctuary in Westport/South Dartmouth

Mass Audubon's Summer Eco Explorers at Allens Pond is a program designed for kids ages 6-10 and is **free** for qualified residents* of New Bedford and surrounding towns, thanks to the generosity of the United Way of Greater New Bedford's Summer Fund. Each family from these communities is eligible to choose ONE of the following sessions:

<u>Session One</u>: Monday July 11th through Thursday, July 14th. This week is located at the Allens Pond Field Station, located at 1280 Horseneck Road in Westport.

<u>Session Two</u>: Monday, July 25th through Thursday, July 28th. This week is located at our Stone Barn Farm, located at 786 East Horseneck Road in South Dartmouth.

The program meets each day from 9:00am until 3:00pm at the designated site. The kids will be out exploring the trails, learning about wildlife and enjoying games, crafts and the company of new friends.

Participants must dress for a day of outdoor discovery, and come prepared with sunscreen and insect repellent already applied. Proper footwear (no flip-flops) and socks are a must. Breakfast, lunch and snack are provided for qualified families* as part of the program. Registration is required.
